
# Our school offers you the following:


- 1 The history of the formation of the urban landscape on the example of the city of Gomel: 2000 years from the hillfort to the city

#### The Chanki

Here are unique arrays of deciduous forests, pine forests typical of Polesie above floodplain terraces and dunes, and black alder forests in the marshes. Hornbeam oak forests are found, having an age of 150-200 years. During the tour it will be possible to get acquainted with the flora and wild fauna of forests and marshes of Polesie.








#### 3. Agricultural and cultural-historical landscapes of Polesie

Elias Church - a monument of wooden architecture of the 18th century






#### **F.G. Shklyarov Vetka Museum of Old Believers and Belarusian traditions** The exposition of the museum includes the famous Vetka Old Believers' icons of the 18th and 20th centuries, blacksmithing objects, as well as a unique collection of handwritten and printed books, woven bench hammers, and folk costumes.



#### 4. Agric ultural, historical and cultural landscapes Village Halch

Palace in the style of late classicism and landscape park (19th century). In the vicinity of the village are the towns of the early Iron Age and the era of Kievan Rus, a burial ground, an early medieval sanctuary.
